- Financial aid is **NOT** available for non-degree students. Students will receive a discounted tuition rate of **\$250/credit**.
- Acceptance as a non-degree student does not guarantee regular acceptance as a degree-seeking student.
- A non-degree student is required to maintain a GPA of 2.0.
- Visiting students are required to determine how courses taken at Regent University will transfer to their home institution. Regent is **NOT** responsible for determining applicability of transfer credit or translation of college credit to high school credit.
